## Fees & Admissions Process

### Withdrawal Policy:

- 1. Withdrawal & Refund of fees will be as per Savitribai Phule Pune University guidelines.
- 3. Request for Withdrawal of admission must be sent through registered email id of the student stating genuine reason for withdrawal on admission@suryadatta.edu.in
- 4. Refund will be made only after submission of proof of original receipt of fees paid and no dues certificate from the concerned department
- 5. The Refund will be made through an account transfer to the authorized account number mentioned on the Email id. Hence correct bank details must be provided in the withdrawal request.
- 6. Processing Fees of Rs 10,000/- will be deducted in case of international students.
- 7. All refunds shall be remitted only to the bank account of the student / parent as per the individual NEFT details furnished and shall be made within 30 working day from the date of approval of cancellation/withdrawal.
- 8. All disputes related to the refund of fees will be subject to Pune Jurisdiction only.
- 9. No admission will be cancelled in the mid of the semester.
- 10. Cancellation will be allowed only till valid eligibility of SPPU as per SPPU cancellation policy.
- 11. A student if does not report to the college for more than 10 days from course commencement date disciplinary action will be taken against the student.

## Rules and **Regulations**

Suryadatta Group of Institutes (SGI) is committed to excellence in education, character building, and holistic development of students. This rulebook outlines the quidelines and code of conduct expected from every student to ensure a disciplined, safe, and conducive academic environment. All students are required to read, understand, and comply with these rules.

### **Admission Rules:**

- 1. Application for admission to all programmes must be made on the prescribed application form only. Photocopies of the form are not acceptable.
- 2. Application form is to be filled by the candidate in his / her own handwriting using ballpoint pen and countersigned by the parents / quardians.
- 3. It is the collective responsibility of the candidate and the parents to submit required documents by the stipulated date.
- 4. Students admitted provisionally must fulfil all pending requirements within the stipulated time. All admissions are confirmed subject to the candidate fulfilling all the prescribed eligibility criteria as decided by the competent bodies and payment of requisite fees.
- 5. Late payment will attract penalties as per institute policy.
- 6. No transfer of fees between programmes or students.
- 7. Failure to do so may result in cancellation of admission.
- 8. Fulfilling the eligibility criteria in itself does not assure admission to a programme. The final decision for admission rests with the Institute / College.
- 9. Mark sheet and School leaving / College leaving certificate of Class X / Class XII and Graduation (wherever applicable) will have to be submitted in original. Self-Attested Photocopies of certificates other than the above will be accepted.
- 10. Original documents (mark sheets, school/college leaving certificate) must be submitted for verification. False or forged documents will lead to cancellation of admission without refund.
- 11. Students and parents are requested to go through the eligibility criteria laid down by the competent authorities for the respective programme. Please note you will be solely responsible if admission stands cancelled due to any non-fulfilment of eligibility criteria at any stage and fees will be refunded as per the rules of the competent authorities.
- 12. Selected candidates will have to join the Institute / College on the notified date.
- 13. Management reserves the right of refusal for final admission.

### Discipline:

1. Students are strictly prohibited from entering the classroom, knocking on the door, or leaving the classroom once the teacher or professor has commenced the lecture. Requests for lecture cancellations directed to the teacher or professor are not permitted. Any behaviour such as peeping into classrooms, making distracting gestures, or similar conduct during lectures will be regarded as acts of misconduct.

- 2. Students are required to adhere to the prescribed code of conduct and must wear the official institute uniform at all times. Footwear such as slippers, as well as casual attire including jeans and T-shirts, are not permitted on campus.
- 3. Students are expected to remain informed of the institute's daily activities and comply with all notices and communications posted on the official notice boards.
- 4. Acts of misconduct such as misbehaviour, tardiness, insubordination, absenteeism, substance abuse, fraudulent practices, and cheating during examinations will result in appropriate disciplinary measures.
- 5. The Institute Directors hold the authority to impose fines on students for any form of misconduct whenever deemed necessary and justified.
- 6. The student's career progression, including attendance, academic performance, and disciplinary record, will be communicated to the parents for their information. It is expected that parents acknowledge this information and respond to the Institute by meeting the Director when requested via letter, email, phone, or SMS.
- 7. Students are required to carry their Identity Card at all times within the Institute premises and during any official visits.
- 8. It is the responsibility of every student to promptly inform the Institute office of any changes in their name or address. Failure to do so may result in significant delays in managing student records and in emergency notifications at home.
- 9. The Institute has an active placement assistance cell dedicated to supporting students in securing suitable employment opportunities aligned with their educational background. However, the Institute does not guarantee the employer, job location, or salary package. Placement assistance is provided based on the student's academic record and overall performance.
- 10. The Institute authorities shall not be held responsible or liable for any loss or damage to students' personal
- 11. Students are prohibited from engaging in any political or antisocial activities within the Institute. Violation of this policy may result in expulsion.
- 12. Ragging in any form is strictly forbidden and will be subject to severe disciplinary action in accordance with Government and Institute regulations.
- 13. Any violation of conduct, whether occurring within or outside the Institute premises, shall be subject to disciplinary action in accordance with applicable laws and regulations.

- 14. The Institute facilitates hostel admissions at accommodations near the campus. Students opting for hostel residence are required to strictly adhere to the rules and regulations outlined in the hostel admission form
- 15. The Institute reserves the right to seek compensation equivalent to the original value for any damage caused to equipment, components, or instruments by students.
- 16. Students are encouraged to fully utilize the available IT facilities to enhance their technical skills. The Institute campus is Wi-Fi enabled, allowing students to access the internet on their laptops throughout the campus, except during academic or lecture hours.
- 17. Each class shall nominate two students as Class Representatives and an additional two students to serve on the Institute's Discipline Committee. These representatives are expected to report regularly to the Faculty-in-Charge and, when necessary, directly to the Director. Students with concerns or grievances may approach Faculty Members, Professors, or Directors for prompt and fair resolution.
- 18. Students must strictly comply with all rules and regulations prescribed by local, state, and central government authorities, as well as those established by competent bodies such as AICTE, University, DTE, UGC, and the Institute. These regulations shall be enforced as applicable and binding at all times.
- 19. The Institute reserves the right to amend, modify, or update its norms, policies, rules, and regulations at its discretion and as deemed necessary.
- 20. In the event of any dispute, the decision of the head of the respective Institute or College shall be final and binding. All legal proceedings shall be subject exclusively to the jurisdiction of Pune.

### **Medical Fitness:**

- Students are required to submit a medical fitness certificate and comply with the following health requirements:
- All students must be vaccinated against common diseases, including Hepatitis, Chickenpox, and Typhoid, prior to enrolment. Additionally, adequate precautions should be taken to prevent illnesses such as Dengue, Malaria, Swine Flu, and other common health concerns.
- 2. It is strongly advised that students with serious preexisting health conditions reconsider admission to the Institute, as the Institute does not assume responsibility for managing such medical issues. In the event that a student develops a serious health condition during the course of study, it is imperative that the student promptly notify the Institute by submitting the relevant medical documentation.
- 3. In case of any medical emergency, hospitalization may be necessary. Students are expected to ensure personal care and, for those residing in the Institute's hostels, receive support from roommates as appropriate. Upon notification, the Institute will provide reasonable assistance; however, all

hospitalization and associated medical expenses shall be the responsibility of the student and/or their parents.

### **Fees Structure and Rules:**

- 1. All fees must be paid through Demand Drafts, Account Transfers, Card Swipes, or NEFT. Cheques will not be accepted under any circumstances.
- Fees once paid are refundable solely in accordance with the regulations established by the competent authorities.
- Students are required to settle all dues, monetary or otherwise, within the prescribed deadlines communicated by the Institute.
- 4. Upon confirmation of admission and commencement of the course, the student is obligated to pay the full course fee as per the stipulated schedule. Late payment penalties & instalment charges will be levied for any delays.
- 5. No capitation fee is charged for admission to any course offered by Suryadatta.
- 6. Fee refunds shall be processed strictly as per the norms prescribed by the relevant authorities.
- Full payment of fees must be completed prior to the start of classes. Once admission registration is finalized, requests for course changes, transfers, or cancellations will not be entertained under any circumstances.
- 8. Compliance for Students Belonging to Reserved Categories: Students under government-recognized reserved categories must submit all required documents on time and comply with applicable rules for fee concessions or scholarships. Delays, incomplete documentation, or changes in policy affecting eligibility will result in full fee liability. Non-payment will lead to automatic admission cancellation and possible disciplinary action.

### **Attendance:**

- 1. Students are expected to maintain regular and punctual attendance in all scheduled classes.
- A minimum attendance of 90% is mandatory, allowing for a 10% exemption to accommodate genuine exigencies. Students failing to achieve at least 80% attendance by the end of the semester or term will be deemed ineligible to appear for the final examination.
- Holiday calendar is displayed on the website and will be conveyed time to time through official communication channels like notices / emails etc.
- 4. Excessive unexcused absences may lead to a student's removal from the class. Non-attendance in tests, examinations, tutorials, and failure to submit assignments on time will render the student disqualified from internal assessment evaluations.
- Participation in all academic and co-curricular activities, including seminars, group discussions, industrial visits, workshops, presentations, guest lectures, yoga sessions, orientation programs, soft

- skills training, foreign language classes, role plays, and supplementary instructional sessions, is compulsory.
- 6. Students must report to their respective classrooms at least 5 to 10 minutes prior to the commencement of lectures to ensure a conducive learning environment and to minimize disruptions for faculty and fellow students.

### **Campus Discipline:**

- 1. Students are required to wear their Identity Cards prominently while on campus at all times.
- 2. Students shall uphold the highest standards of discipline in accordance with the directives issued by the organizational authorities and the Head of the Institution/College.
- 3. Access to the Computer Lab and Library is permitted before and after scheduled classes as per the published timetable. The campus-wide Wi-Fi facility is available for student use within designated hours.
- 4. Possession of a valid Library Card is mandatory for accessing the Library and Reading Room facilities on campus.
- 5. Maintaining silence, personal hygiene, and cleanliness throughout the campus is compulsory.
- 6. Students found responsible for damage to Institute property or equipment shall be liable to pay fines equivalent to the full cost of repair or replacement, in accordance with Institute/College regulations.
- 7. Strict compliance with the Institute's dress code and uniform policy is required. Wearing the official uniform and Identity Card is compulsory during all classes, seminars, guest lectures, and official visits.
- 8. Any involvement in theft, malpractice during examinations or tests, or sexual misconduct, whether within or outside the Institute/College premises, will attract disciplinary action as per applicable Institute and local authority regulations.
- 9. Students are advised not to bring valuables such as jewellery, laptops, or other expensive items to campus. If brought, the Institute assumes no responsibility for loss or damage and such items are carried at the student's own risk.
- 10. In accordance with the rules and regulations of the competent authorities, the use of mobile phones on campus is strictly prohibited. Students are advised not to bring mobile phones to the Institute/College. Any mobile phones brought shall be at the owner's own risk.
- 11. Students must securely lock and park their vehicles only in designated areas, at their own risk.
- 12. Use of inappropriate social media sites or violation of Information Technology policies is strictly forbidden. Violation will result in stringent disciplinary measures involving both students and their parents.
- 13. It is the responsibility of each student to regularly check and stay informed of all notices posted on the official Notice Boards regarding institutional activities and instructions.

- 14. Students are expected to conduct themselves with moral integrity, ethical behaviour, and professionalism throughout their tenure at Suryadatta Group of Institutes.
- 15. Students are encouraged to avoid unnecessary wastage of water and electricity and contribute to campus sustainability efforts.
- 16. During online classes, students must maintain discipline and adhere strictly to the prescribed code of conduct.

### **Academics:**

- 1. Students are strictly prohibited from undertaking any form of employment, whether full-time or part-time, as it may adversely affect their health, attendance, and academic performance.
- 2. Prior written permission from the concerned Director of the Institution/College is mandatory for availing leave. Unauthorized absence will result in disciplinary action, and habitual absenteeism without notification may lead to cancellation of admission.
- 3. Students are required to submit assignments, participate in internal examinations, fieldwork, projects, and other academic activities within the stipulated deadlines and in accordance with the programme and Institute/College guidelines. Relevant schedules will be available on the respective Institute's/College's notice boards.
- 4. Completion and timely submission of all homework assignments assigned by faculty members is compulsory.
- 5. Submission of tutorials, assignments, tests, and engagement in other academic activities are essential and mandatory components of the curriculum.
- 6. The College organizes various co-curricular, cultural, and extracurricular activities throughout the academic year, and student participation in these events is mandatory to facilitate holistic development.


### **Hostel:**

- 1. Hostels, paying guest accommodations, and rented lodgings are available in proximity to the campus. Students residing in these accommodations must strictly adhere to the rules and regulations prescribed by the respective authorities & comply with local laws.
- 2. It is strongly recommended that all outstation students avail themselves of the hostel facilities during their first year for better integration and convenience.

### Other Rules & Regulations:

1. The Institute organizes Industrial Visits, training sessions, fieldwork, seminars, conferences, yoga and meditation programs on campus, as well as outdoor training camps for comprehensive student development. Students are expected to fully engage in these activities and strictly adhere to all established rules, regulations, disciplinary protocols, and safety guidelines to safeguard their well-being.

- Students are required to periodically submit a medical certificate issued by a certified medical practitioner as part of ongoing health monitoring.
- 3. Participation in industrial visits will be granted based on student performance criteria, including attendance, conduct, compliance with assignments, and engagement in academic activities, among others.
- 4. The Institute/College reserves the right to revise, amend, or update its norms, rules, and regulations at its discretion from time to time.
- 5. The Director, Principal, and Management retain full authority to take appropriate disciplinary action against students who violate the stipulated guidelines.
- 6. In the event of any dispute, the final and binding decision shall rest solely with the Director or Principal of the respective Institute/College.
- 7. For personal safety, students must comply with all applicable traffic regulations, wear helmets when riding two-wheelers, and carry all necessary documentation at all times.
- It is advised that students refrain from using smartphones on campus in order to minimize distractions, avoid social media misuse, and make efficient use of their time.
- 9. During pandemics or epidemics, students are expected to strictly follow all government-mandated health and safety protocols without exception.
- 10. Consumption of food and beverages inside classrooms is prohibited. Students must refrain from littering, such as discarding papers or empty bottles on campus or within classrooms, and actively support the "Clean India, Green India" initiative.
- 11. Upon leaving the classroom, students are responsible for closing windows, switching off fans and lights, arranging chairs neatly, and ensuring the space is left in proper order.
- 12. Students are not permitted to bring friends or relatives into the campus premises without prior written authorization from the appropriate authorities. Unauthorized entry may result in strict disciplinary measures, including detention or expulsion.
- Students are required to cooperate fully with security personnel during routine identity card verification and uniform checks.
- 14. Any request for additional facilities must be formally submitted through a written application to the relevant office.
- 15. Students should regularly visit the respective Institute/College website to stay updated on notices, schedules, and other important communications.

### **Anti-Ragging:**

- Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited within and outside the Institute premises. Students must abstain from any acts of ragging as defined under the Supreme Court directives and Government regulations, and any violation shall attract severe disciplinary and legal action.
- Students must immediately report any incident or threat of ragging to the designated Anti-Ragging Committee or Nodal Officer of the Institute. The Institute provides a confidential and accessible complaint mechanism, including helpline support, to ensure prompt redressal.
- Participation in ragging or abetting such acts, whether directly or indirectly, will lead to strict punitive measures, including suspension, expulsion, rustication, and possible criminal prosecution as per the laws of the land.
- 4. The Institute mandates induction programs, awareness sessions, and continuous monitoring through Anti-Ragging Committees and squads to prevent ragging and promote a safe, inclusive environment for all students.
- 5. All students shall submit a signed anti-ragging undertaking during admission, acknowledging their understanding of these rules and their commitment to maintaining a ragging-free campus.

### I DECLARE AND UNDERTAKE THAT:

- I have thoroughly read, comprehended, and accepted all codes of discipline, academic standards, rules and regulations, and mandatory information as detailed in the admission prospectus, Institute website, and accompanying undertakings. I shall duly acknowledge and adhere to all communications issued by the Institute from time to time.
- I am fully aware that ragging is strictly prohibited across all educational institutions in accordance with the Supreme Court directives and Government regulations. I undertake not to engage in any form of ragging or related activities, failing which I shall be subject to disciplinary measures as prescribed.
- 3. I commit to collecting all original and relevant documents from the Institute within a period of three months following the completion of my programme.
- 4. I acknowledge that the Institute shall not be held liable for any loss or misplacement of my documents if they remain uncollected beyond the stipulated timeframe post-programme completion.




